WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-3a, permits an increase in the bid threshold if a Qualified Purchasing Agent is appointed as well as granted the authorization to negotiate and award such contracts below the bid threshold; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:34-5 et seq. establishes the criteria for qualifying as a Qualified Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, Joseph J. Barcellona possesses the designation of Qualified Purchasing Agent as issued by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in accordance with N. J. A. C. 5:34-5 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Bernards Township Board of Education desires to increase the bid threshold as provided in N. J. S. A. 18A:18A-3; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the governing body of the Bernards Township Board of Education, in the County of Somerset, in the State of New Jersey hereby increases its bid threshold to \$25,000.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the governing body hereby appoints Joseph J. Barcellona as the Qualified Purchasing Agent to exercise the duties of a purchasing agent pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-2b, with specific relevance to the authority, responsibility, and accountability of the purchasing activity of the Board of Education; and be it further
