What are Elementary Summer Activity courses?

Summer Activity courses provide fun, challenging, and exciting learning opportunities, which capitalize on the different "intelligences" of children. These courses are offered to any elementary student (K-5) in the district. Instructors are certified teachers within the Bernards Township school system.

- All courses are held between 10:45 a.m. and 3:15 p.m. at Mount Prospect School, 111 Hansom Road, Basking Ridge.
- Each course runs Monday through Thursday, an hour a day for two weeks and includes eight classes. The dates for each session are as follows:

Session 1:

Week 1: Thursday, July 1st; Tuesday, July 6th - Thursday July 8th

Week 2: Monday, July 12th - Thursday July 15th

Session 2:

Week 1: Monday, July 19th through Thursday, July 22nd

Week 2: Monday, July 26th through Thursday, July 29th

- Please use your child's current grade when registering for classes; a student now in kindergarten may enroll in a kindergarten class.
- **Lunch Break-** In order to accommodate students who attend morning recreation programs or have a full schedule of summer activity classes, a break will be provided from 12:45-1:15 for students to have a snack/lunch. If your child will be attending the program during this time, please send your child with a small snack as part of his/her daily routine.
- Tuition is \$115 per student for each eight-day course. Checks should be made payable to the "Bernards Township Board of Education".
- PLEASE ISSUE A SEPARATE CHECK FOR EACH COURSE IN WHICH YOUR CHILD IS ENROLLED.
- Registration is on a first come, first serve basis and will close once a course is filled. Therefore, please send in your registration right away.
- You may select as many as four courses in Session 1 and four courses in Session 2 for a total of eight summer classes.

- It is important to select alternate(s) for each course, especially if you are interested in registering your child for a full day of scheduling (10:45-3:15). All first choices will be honored as long as the courses have openings.
- Please send your registration forms and checks in an envelope marked "Summer Activities Program" to your child's teacher.
- Confirmations will be sent home via e-mail beginning the week of 5/24/10
- The Summer Activities Program strives to maintain a ratio of 10-15 students per teacher.
- Students should behave in an appropriate manner. School rules of conduct apply to summer programs. Any student who violates the rules may be removed from the program. Please discuss this with your child.
- Please be considerate of our staff and pick up your child no later than 10 minutes after scheduled dismissal time.

Grades K-2

African Safari

Grades K-3

Get your passport and bags ready as we travel to East Africa. Each day we will learn about the wild animals that we encounter on our African safari and learn to speak a little Swahili, too! You will need your binoculars, as we are sure to spot the punda milia (zebra), twiga (giraffe), tembo (elephant), kifarua (rhinoceros), kiboko (hippopotamus), simba (lion) and more! Join us for an amazing trip through Africa.

Bananagrams

Grades 2-5

Come play the word puzzle game that is the new craze! It will drive you BANANAS! Bananagrams is an anagram game designed to make words from tiles. It may sound familiar, but there is a twist...a banana theme. There is no board and everyone plays at the same time. You don't have to "wait your turn". This makes the game exciting and fast. Baseball

Grades 2-5

No sport says summer more than baseball. Come hit, throw, catch, and run with us as we learn about the game of baseball. Students will learn fundamentals, practice skills, and play a game each day, rain or shine. All skill levels are welcome. Participants should bring their own mitt and bat.

Grades 2-5

Grades 1-5

Caldecotts and Crafts

Grades K-3

Sit back and enjoy read-a-louds of some of your favorite Caldecott books such as Click Clack Moo, Cows That Type and Make Way for Ducklings! Then have fun working on different craft projects and activities that tie in with their themes. This is a gold medal class!

Chess Club

Grades K-5

What move will your pawn make? Join the Chess Club to decide! Beginning students will be introduced to the basic rules and strategies of chess and develop their problem solving skills. Intermediate and advanced players will explore the use of expert strategies. Students will be grouped based on their level of playing and will have an opportunity to move into a more advanced group if necessary. (Please indicate your child's level of playing on the registration form.) This class will culminate in a voluntary chess tournament.

Clay, Clay, Clay

Grades K-5

If you like to work with your hands, this is the course for you. Learn how to make pots, a mask, a piñata, and animals out of Mexican quick-dry clay. Each day we will either be creating our pieces or painting them. During our last class, we will even make our own clay, which you can take home with you. Recipes for clay-making will be provided. Please bring a smock, apron or old shirt to use as a cover-up for your clothes. We will be having a great time and getting messy!

Create Your Own Musical

Grades 3-5

Broadway, here we come! Here is your chance to create and perform in your own musical. From writing the script, to acting and set design, we'll do it all. Bring your instruments, singing voices, and artistic energy. Finale... a LIVE performance.

Creative Doll Making

Grades 3-5

Ever wanted to make your own doll? Now is your chance! These identity dolls are made from recycled and unconventional materials. Famous artist Faith Ringgold created this technique. Students will personalize their dolls by utilizing materials that are important to them. These dolls are not only functional but a fine work of art that can be displayed anywhere!

Creative Music, Movement, and Musical Games

Grades K-5

We are going to have lots of fun exploring the sounds of different instruments and finding ways that we can move to music. This class will be full of musical games, songs, and various classroom instruments to ensure an enjoyable hands-on experience while learning at the same time! Come and move and make music!

Creative Writing

Grades 3-5

This class is great for students interested in writing their own poetry, short fiction and autobiographies. Students enhance their love of the written word as well as practical composition skills through creative exercises, peer critique and an emphasis on point of view, description, voice and theme.

Crime Busters

Grades K-5

Would you like to be a forensic scientist? Together we will unravel make-believe crimes using science tools and scientific analysis. Students will use a microscope, star charts, fingerprints, and chemical reactions to identify the culprits. If you enjoy solving mysteries, join us for Crime Busters!

Digital StoryTelling

Grades 4-5

Digital Storytelling is the art of turning a personal narrative into a multimedia experience. It can combine music, video and/or still images with your creative voice. The results are an original production that engages the viewing audience in ways that are often surprising and powerful. Digital Storytelling can be used to introduce or reinforce the power of writing. Through the writing process and its refinement, students will discover the power of personal expression and greater creativity with digital tools at their aid.

Dream It, Build It

Grades K-5

Use multimedia to make the creations of your dreams. You may work with Lincoln Logs, K'NEX, Lego and even paper to make anything you can imagine. Build your dream house out of Lincoln Logs or Legos, and your dream car out of K'NEX. Instructions are provided to guide you or you can build

free-style. We will even build with food during our last session. Build whatever you like, it's your choice!

Drama Kids

Grades 2-5

This class is loads of fun for energetic, enthusiastic, dramatic kids! We will learn about different types of theatre such as monologues, skits and plays. Students will develop their imagination, self-confidence, personal expression, and public speaking skills while learning all about drama. At the end of the course students will perform a short play. If you love to act, or just want to learn how, this is the course for you!

Elementary Engineering

Grades K-5

Calling all engineers, Let's build microbots. Students will make little robots that move. We will create N'NEX micro-bots such as scooter, speedy, crawler, and hopper. We will also combine some microbots to make new microbots including scooter/hopperbot and a speedy/crawlerbot. Our microbots will even have a relay race to see which microbot is the fastest. Let's have fun and build away!

Fun with Physics

Grades 1-5

Together we will investigate the way things work through hands-on projects that focus on answering the question, "Why?" Learn the three laws of motion, how bubbles work, how to make a spud rocket and Bernoulli's Principle. The final hands on activity will be making ice cream!

Funky Fashions Summertime Edition

Grades K-5

Don't be afraid to make a splash. Dive in and make some summer Funky Fashions and Trendy Treasures. Your friends will go crazy trying to figure out where you bought those awesome accessories. Students will make and design jewelry, hair ties, summer apparel such as Hawaiian accessories and beach wear, and even fabulous flip-flops. So come join the summertime fashion craze and sign up for this course. The last day of class the students will be hitting the runway to show off their apparel at our Luau celebration. New and improved for 2010!

Get Hooked on Latch Hooking

Grades 1-5

Get hooked! Latch hooking is the latest old-school craft craze. Latch hooking is cool, fun, and easy to do. Develop your eye hand coordination and fine motor control while having fun creating popular latch hook projects. So keep your hands busy this summer and join this class!

GO

Grades 1-5

Discover the world's oldest board game, GO. This game originated in ancient China and uses many offensive and defensive strategic skills. Players will use colored pieces to try and control as much area on the board as possible. The focus in this class will be to understand and improve strategy and reasoning skills.

HyperStudio

Grades 3-5

Computer technicians wanted! Create and design slides using the computer program Hyperstudio. Students will create a kid friendly power point presentation on a topic of their choice using this program. Students will explore the use of drawing tools, text, clip art, animation and the Internet during this course. Come and improve your computer skills and have fun at the same time!

Incredible Inventors

Grades K-5

Creative thinkers Wanted! Can you design and build the tallest tower, strongest bridge, coolest robot, most useful invention, funniest animal and more? Each day the students will be given a challenge, along with Physics tips, to help them design and build best structure they can. Students will use their choice of material such as clay, sticks, paper, pipe cleaners, tape, and more. Students will have opportunities to work with their friends and alone as they try to win the challenge of the day.

It's Not Easy Being Green-Reduce, Reuse, and Create!

Grades K-5

In this class students will learn about ways to save the environment and will make eco-friendly projects out of recyclable materials, participate in recycling project, play go green games and do some gardening. Students will also have a chance to make a difference in their neighborhoods with a community service project while raising community awareness at the same time!

Just Dance

Grades 2-5

Do you like music and love to dance? If so, come and join us for a dance party! In this class you will work up a sweat and show off your moves. Some of the dances we will learn include the *Cha Cha Slide*, *Electric Slide*, *Chicken Dance*, and High School Musical's *We're All in this Together*, *Thriller* and much more. After you learn these dance moves you will be hit at the next party!

Kids Can Compose Too!

Grades 2-5

The students will learn about various styles of music, composers from different eras, and what makes the music successful. The young musicians will have a chance to create and perform their own music through improvisation and composition. Students may bring any recorders, band, or orchestra equipment that they can play however no prior experience is necessary.

Kid Concoctions!

Grades K-5

This class will teach you how to create exciting new projects quickly, easily, and inexpensively using household items. Learn how to use common objects found around the house in a fun and creative way. This summer you can learn to be a kitchen magician by taking this class based on the book, The Ultimate Book of Kid Concoctions 2 by John and Danita Thomas.

Krunchies: Healthy Snack Recipes

Grades K-5

Throughout this course students will take part in individual and group cooking projects while learning how to cook healthy and nutritious food. Students will prepare delicious snacks, learn some basic concepts of good nutrition and develop skills such as vocabulary, understanding of numbers,

small muscle coordination, independence and teamwork. Each day students will go home with a new nutritious and delicious recipe!

Landscape Painting

Grades 2-5

Learn to paint breathtaking landscapes. Explore the strategies and techniques for creating fluffy white clouds, majestic mountains, dynamic trees, rolling fields and reflective lakes. Each landscape is as unique as its painter.

Let's Play Cards

Grades K-5

Playing cards can improve strategic thinking, computation skills, give students practice in cooperation, and just be plain old fun! Students are going to sit back, relax and have loads of fun playing new and old card games together. Card games will include War, Go Fish, Spit, Rummy and other new games. Students will be encouraged to share any games they know with classmates as well. So come and learn some new card games to impress your family and friends or just have some good old-fashioned fun playing some old favorites!

Life's a Beach

Grades 1-4

Come celebrate summer! We will make lots of crafts using a variety of materials to decorate for summer or to use at the beach. Learn how to draw ocean animals, make a thermometer, bead a sunglass holder, and even make some tasty summer treats. Surf's up in this class!

Making Musical Instruments

Grades K-5

In this course students will have the opportunity to create their own instruments such as rain sticks, box guitars, drums, and other exciting instruments from household items. We will also learn how to make music with these instruments as each project is completed. Students may also have the opportunity to invent and name their own instruments.

Math Wizards

Grades 2-5

Learn math computation tricks to amaze your friends and family members. Students will use math skills and concepts to engage in math problem solving activities and situations. Students can choose to participate in math games and learn math tricks to become the ultimate math magician!

Musical Theatre

Grades K-5

We will be playing instruments and singing, all with a circus theme. Get your music ears on and come play with us. Invite your friends and family to our "Big Top" final performance.

Paper Airplanes for Kids

Grades K-5

Do you have the right stuff? If you have ever dreamed of being a pilot, the paper airplanes and activities in this class will make you feel like you are flying! Many of the paper airplanes you will create are based on actual airplanes such as the Thunderhawk and the Thunderdart. Other projects include aviation marvels like rockets. You will also have fun learning awesome activities you can do with your brand new paper airplanes.

Podcasting

Grades 2-5

Would you like to have your own radio show and listen to it on your computer or ipod/MP3 player? In this course we will use computers and microphones to record our voices and make Podcasts (audio files). Students will listen to sample Podcasts and then brainstorm other Podcasting ideas. Students will learn how to use the program *Audacity* to record their voice, edit their files and then add music and sound effects. Students will enjoy listening to their classmates Podcasts as well as their own!

Pretty, Pretty, Princess

Grades K-2

Calling all princesses. Let your inner princess come out and shine! Students will be enchanted after listening to some delightful stories and creating "sparkling" crafts from tiaras to magic wands and more. Each day students will leave with something magical. Come join us for a spectacular time!

Quilling: A Rolled Paper Decorative Art

Grades 1-5

In this class you will be all wound up over strips of colorful, delicate paper! Students will learn how to turn, twist, and pinch paper into menstuate forms to design elaborate and elegant crafts of art. Quilling can decorate personalized greeting cards, holiday ornaments, picture frames and adhere to fabric or board as an art image on its own. The possibilities in quilling are endless.

Read, Learn and Make

Grades K-2

Join us for some fun story time this summer while practicing all those reading strategies you learned in school. We will read and discuss a new book each day as we practice reading with expression, learn new vocabulary and boost comprehension. After each book there will be a variety of engaging activities like creative crafts, songs or games to help extend students' imaginations and inspire a love of reading!

Rocketry

Grades 2-5

Have you ever wondered how an airplane works or how rockets get into outer space? Do you like making things and seeing how they work? If so, this aerospace engineering class may be the one for you. In this class students will learn how Newton's laws of motion are used to help overcome the

forces of gravity and explore why rockets are useful in society. Students will make a series of paper airplanes and test them outside as well as make and paint their own rockets. Finally, during our rocket launch, all the rocket scientists will watch their creations soar up to 500 feet into the air!

Science Olympics

Grades 2-5

Here is the chance to participate in a competitive challenge that demonstrates the fun side of science. The Science Olympics is a series of events related to a wide range of science topics. Teams will use science skills and ideas to develop creative solutions to problems such as; how can I make a bridge out of a newspaper? How many marbles can I put in an aluminum foil boat before it sinks? How can I make a straw tower strong enough to hold a tennis ball? Test your solutions, compete with your friends, and go for the gold!

Science Toys

Grades 1-5

Discover principles of science by making toys. Students will use common materials to construct toys to explore Newton's Laws of motion, friction and gravity. Some of the toys that will be made are a moving woodpecker, a parachute, tops and a tumbling acrobat!

Scrapbooking Mania

Grades 1-5

Think back to your fondest memories...*birthdays, Halloween, sleepovers, vacations!* Do you want to hold onto these memories until you are 100 years old? Join us for Scrapbooking Mania! Students will learn how to create perfect pages using matting, journaling, and unusual art accents. Bring your favorite photos and leave each class with beautiful scrapbook pages.

Sign Language for Everyone

Grades K-5

Come learn basic American Sign Language through games and activities. If you like to learn new languages or you think sign language is fun, then this is the class for you. By the end of the session students will know how to fingerspell their names and those of family and friends, animal names, and many other words and phrases. Students will even learn how to sign some songs! Come join the singing fun!

Silk-Screening & Print Making

Grades 1-5

Create your own graphics and original layered pictures through a variety of printing techniques. This class will introduce the artist to printing with found objects, oil resist printing, pressed paper and embossed paper and tin techniques. Projects include stationery, journal covers, bookmarks, and art illustrations to be displayed.

Soaring Science

Grades 2-5

How do birds fly? Why are there more birds here in the summer? Does the shape of a feather really matter? What bird was that? Come on a scientific adventure to answer these questions and many more. Get ready to take flight as we explore the world of birds and flight through hands-on experiments, interactive games, field guides, and crafts- including nest construction, making paper

airplanes, and finding your wingspan. Come join this class if you've ever dreamed of flying with the birds but didn't know how!

The "Friend Ship"

Grades K-5

All aboard! Come cruise with us on the SS Friend-"ship" where friendship matters. Your cruise director will be calling all hands on deck to create a resource box full of fun strategies for making new friends, fixing a rocky friendship, and being heard without being mean. With your activity director you will be making memory scrapbooks, friendship pillows, peas-in-a-pod necklaces, friendship repair kits and note cards to send a friendly letter. Your chef will help you prepare a friendship cupcake, and a variety of pot luck snacks and desserts meant to be prepared with a group of your friends. All friends are invited on the Lido-deck for a celebration of friendship at the bon-voyage party on our final day. So ALL ABOARD!

Toy Factory

Grade K-5

Welcome to the toy factor where you will be creating and assembling our own toys. Let's see you try your hand at making your own horse for horse races, air-golf for a tournament, soap box cars for the soap box derby, parachute fliers, kites, personalized checkers and board, boomerangs, stilts and glider planes, to name just a few. If you think being a toy maker is fun, just think how much fun you will have playing with the toys you make. So visit the toy factory and jump on the assembly line where toys are BIG BUSINESS!

Travel the Seven Continents

Grades K-4

Do you like to travel? Join me as we travel the seven continents, learning interesting facts and traditions of the different countries that make up each continent. Students will create their own world map and travel diary showcasing our exciting travels from continent to continent. Come and join us as we travel around the world!

Writing for Meaning

Grades K-2

Your child has worked hard this year improving his/her writing. This class will build on that learning and energize students so their writing continues to be a natural extension of their self-expression. We will explore authentic examples of writing where children can view writing as a tool to help them explain their ideas. Children will easily relate to the varieties of writing that can be applied to their everyday lives.
