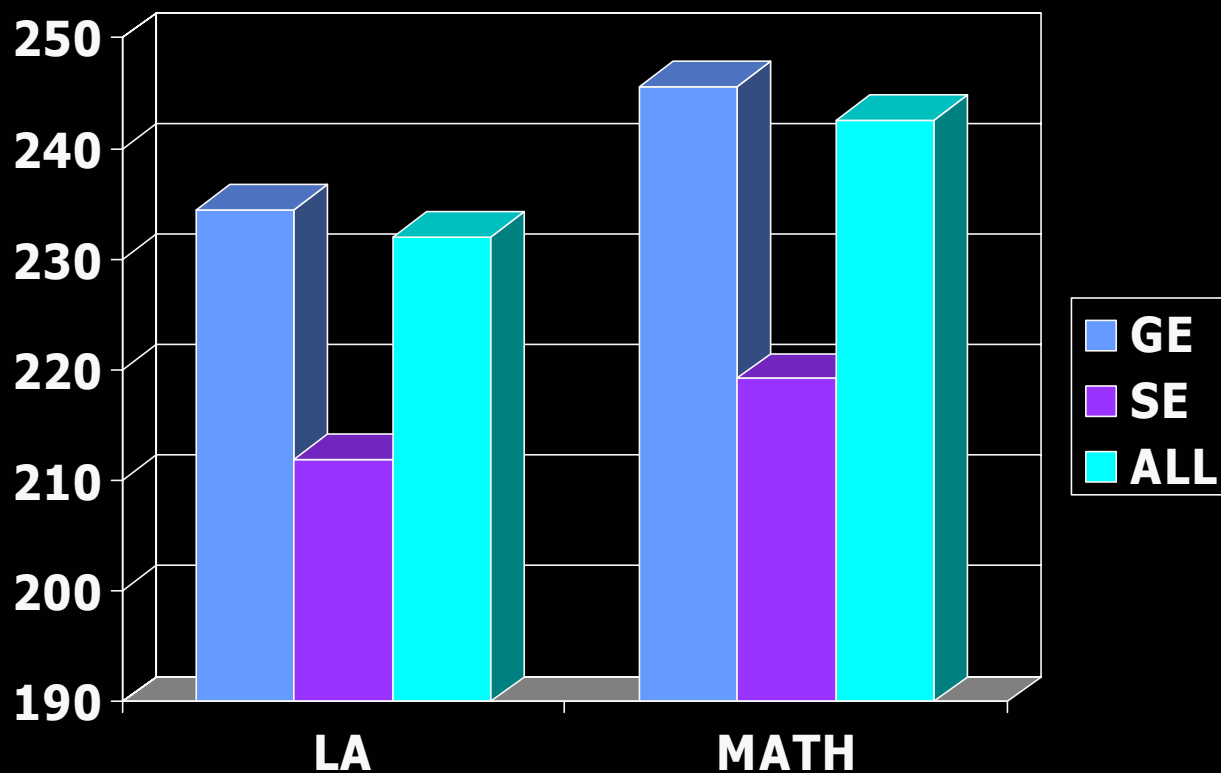

NJ ASK – Grade 4 Mean Scale Scores – District

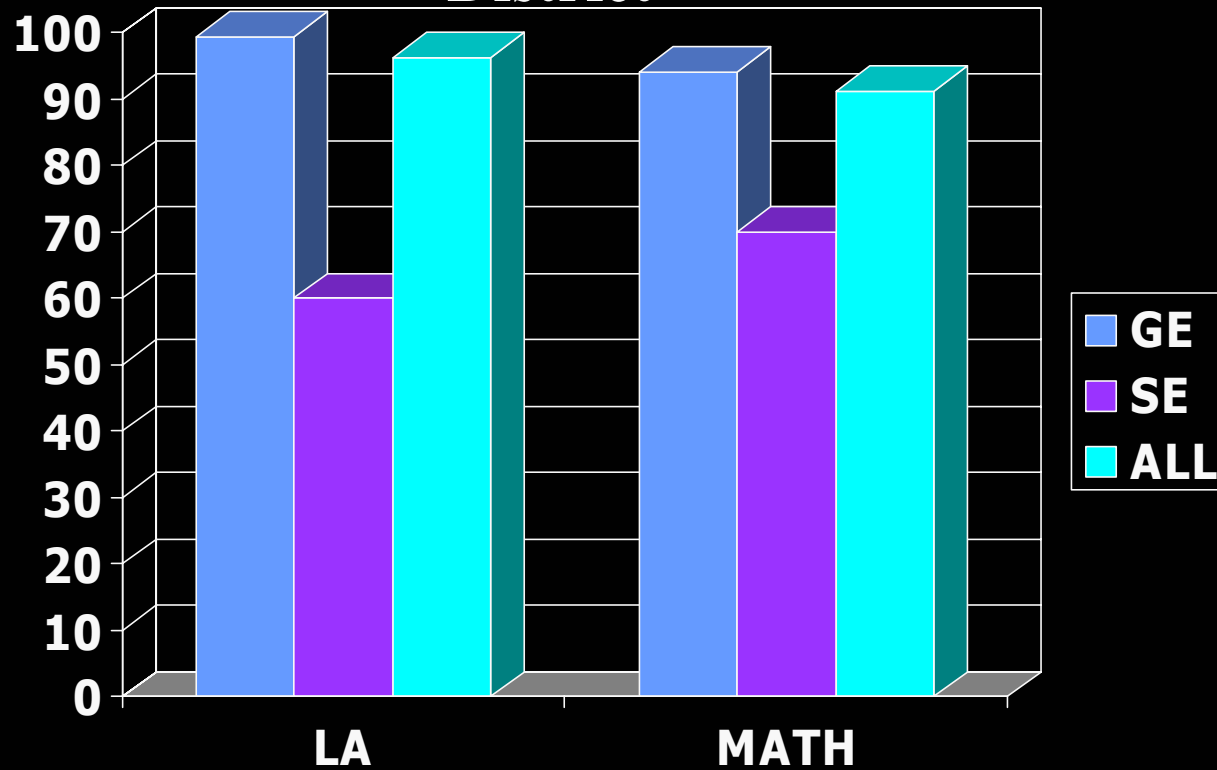

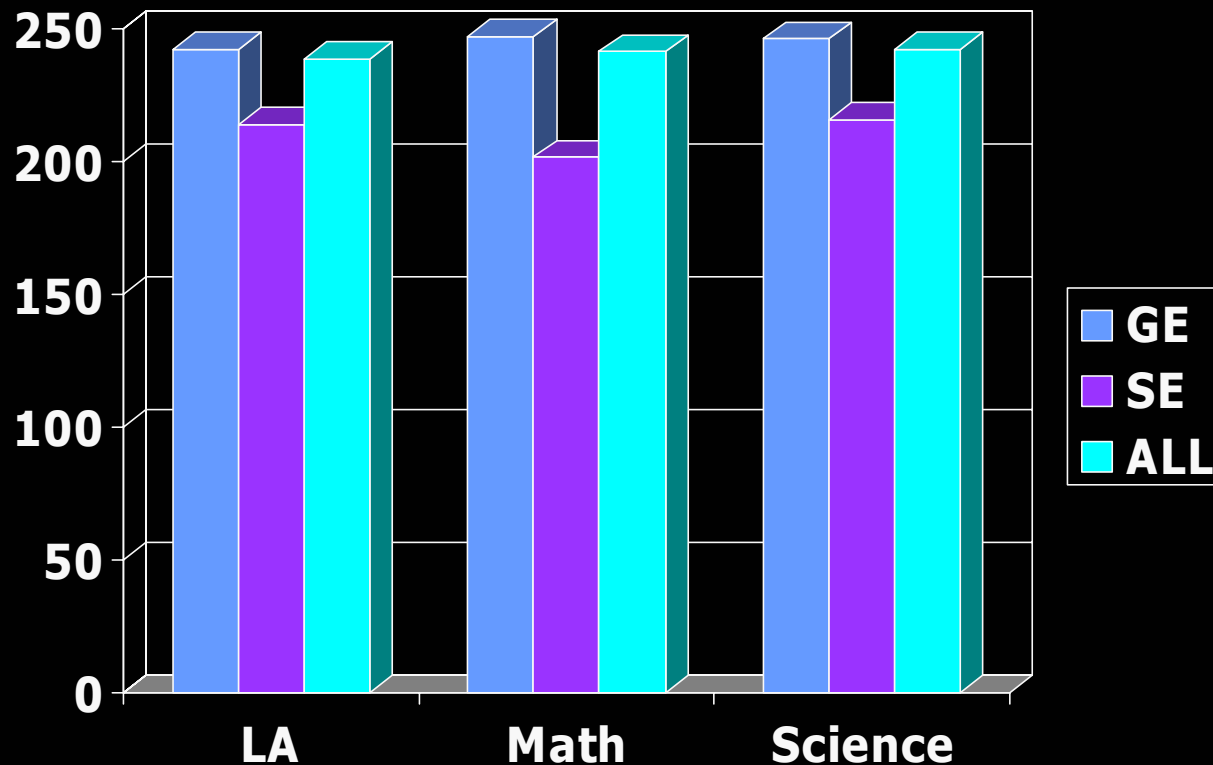

District**



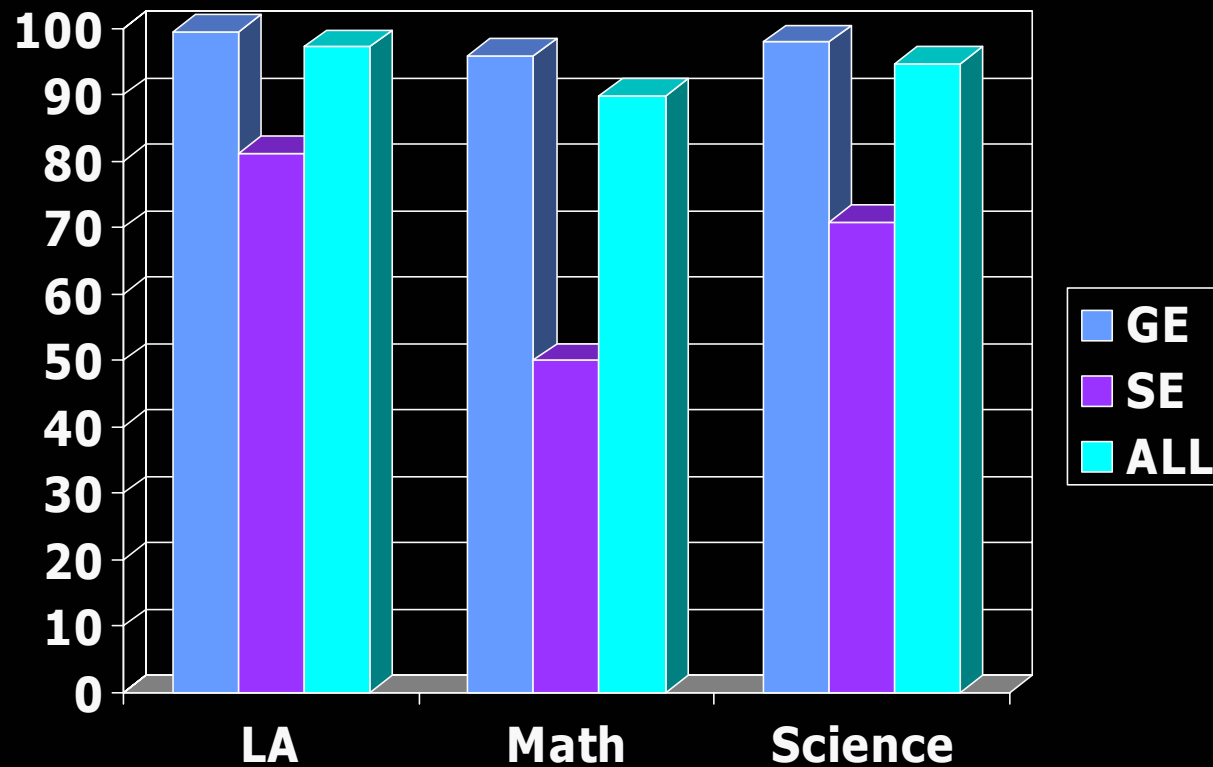
GEPA (2003) – Grade 8

Percent At or Above State Standards - District



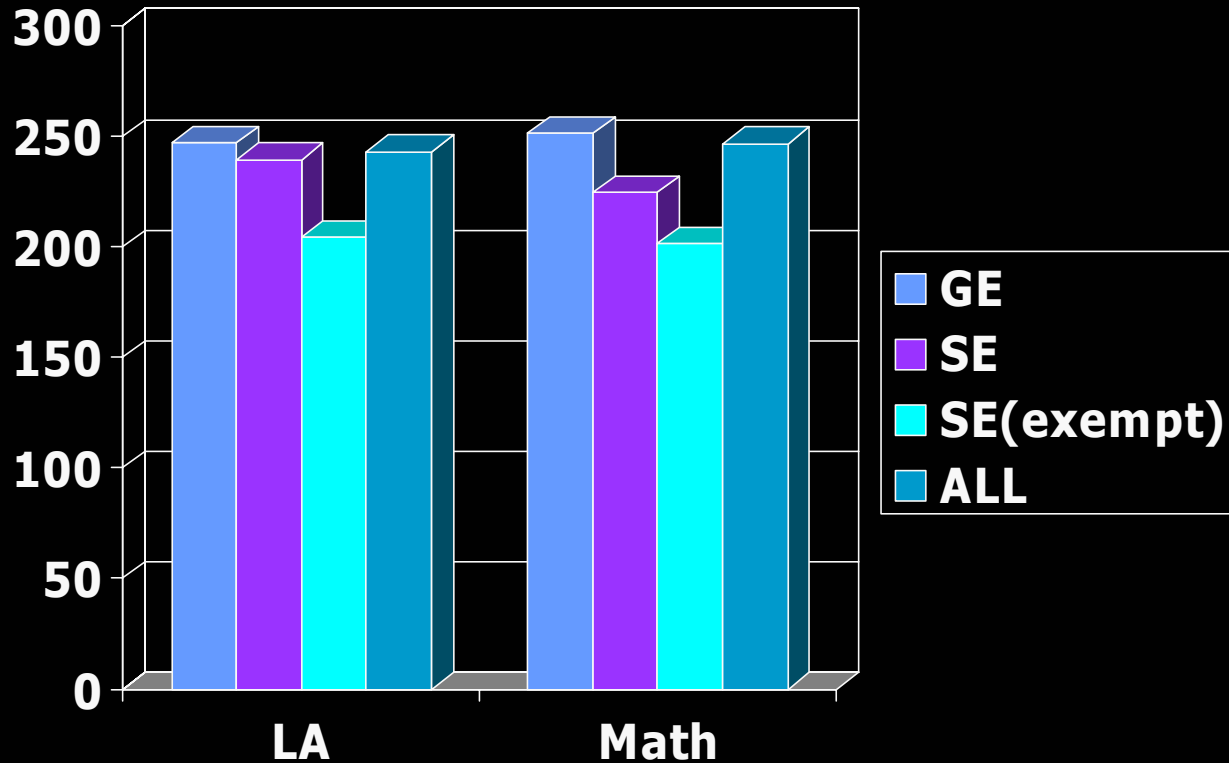

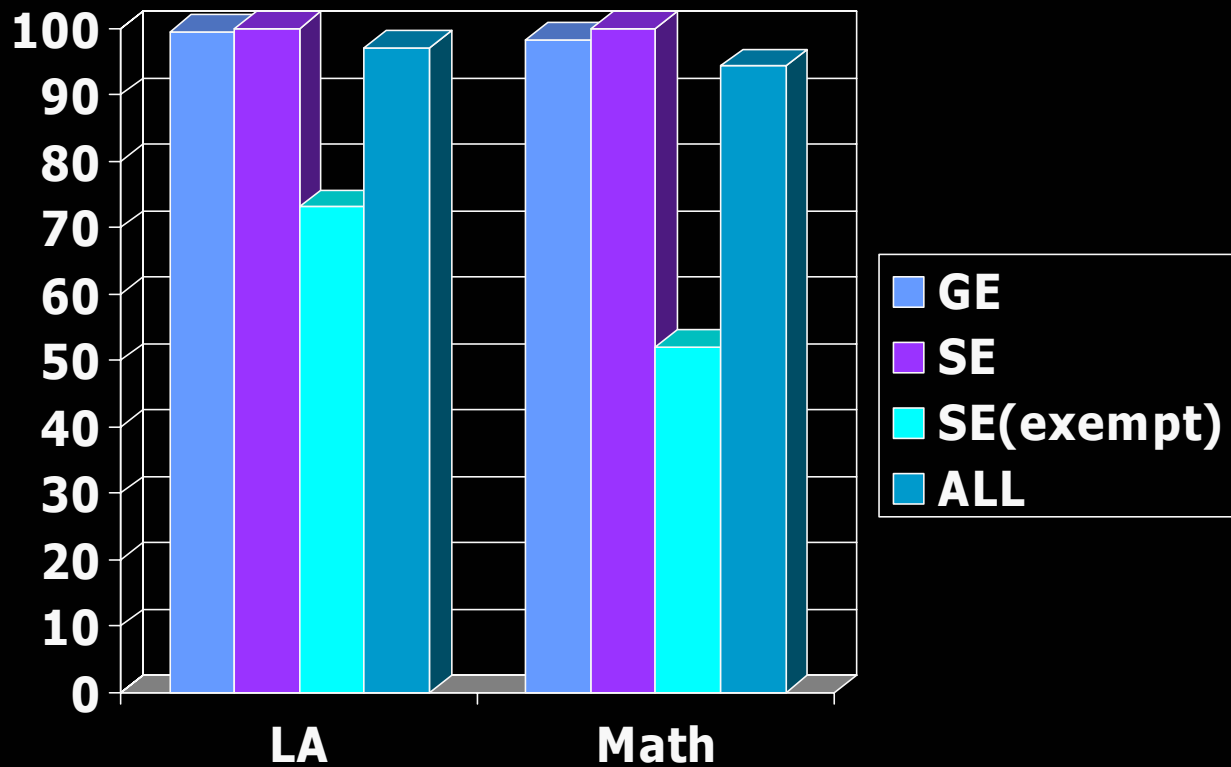

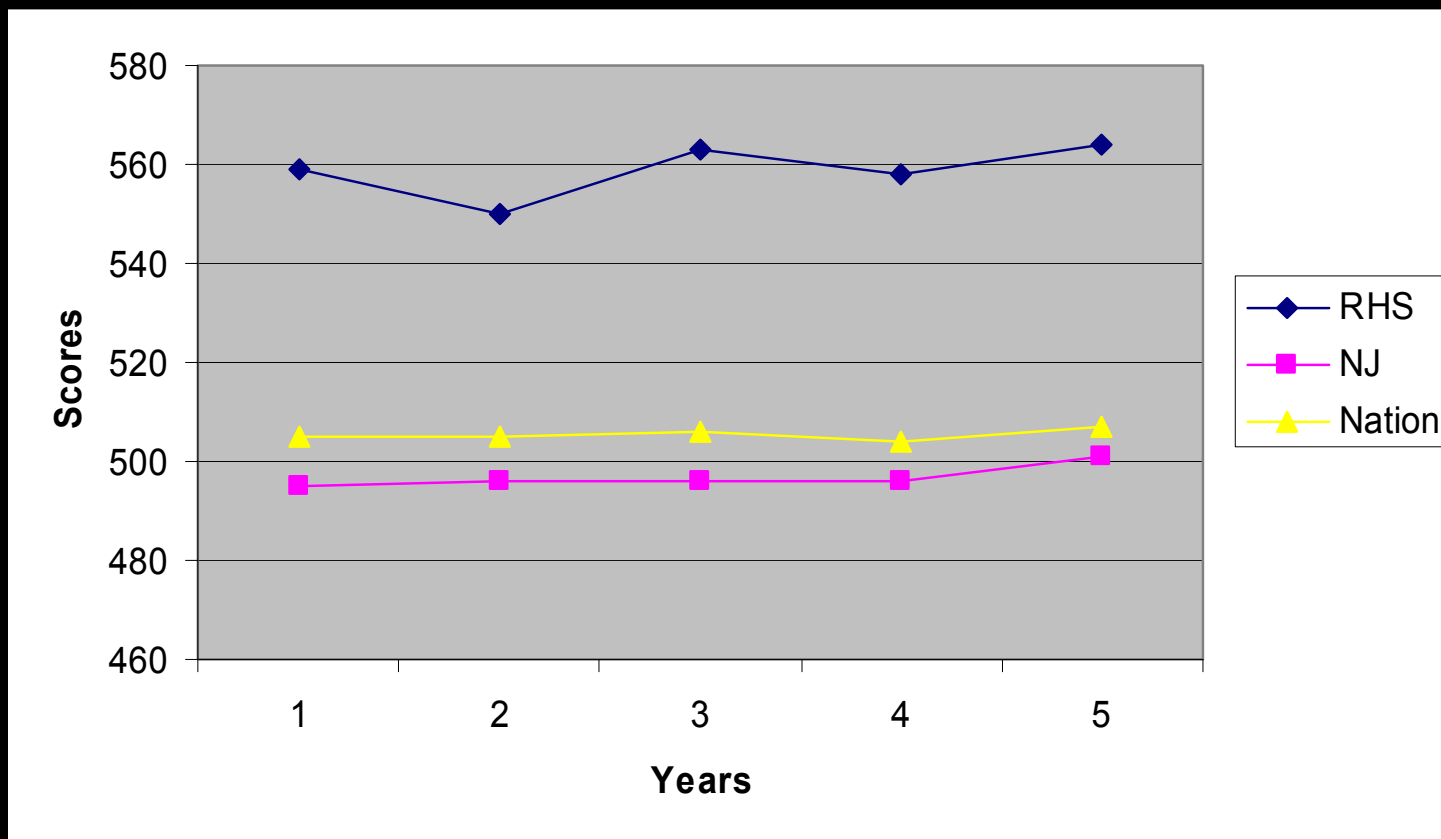

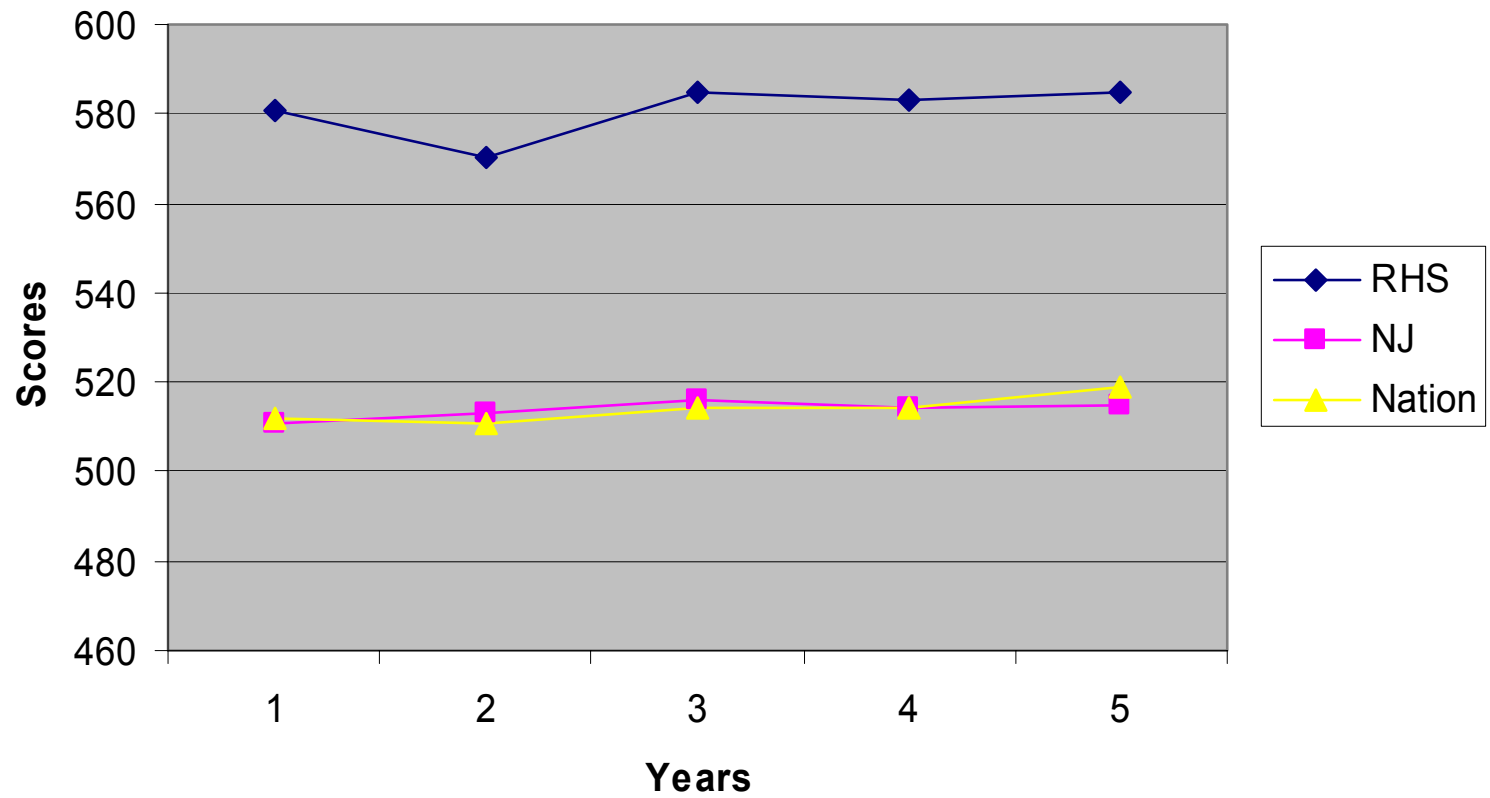
SAT-I Verbal

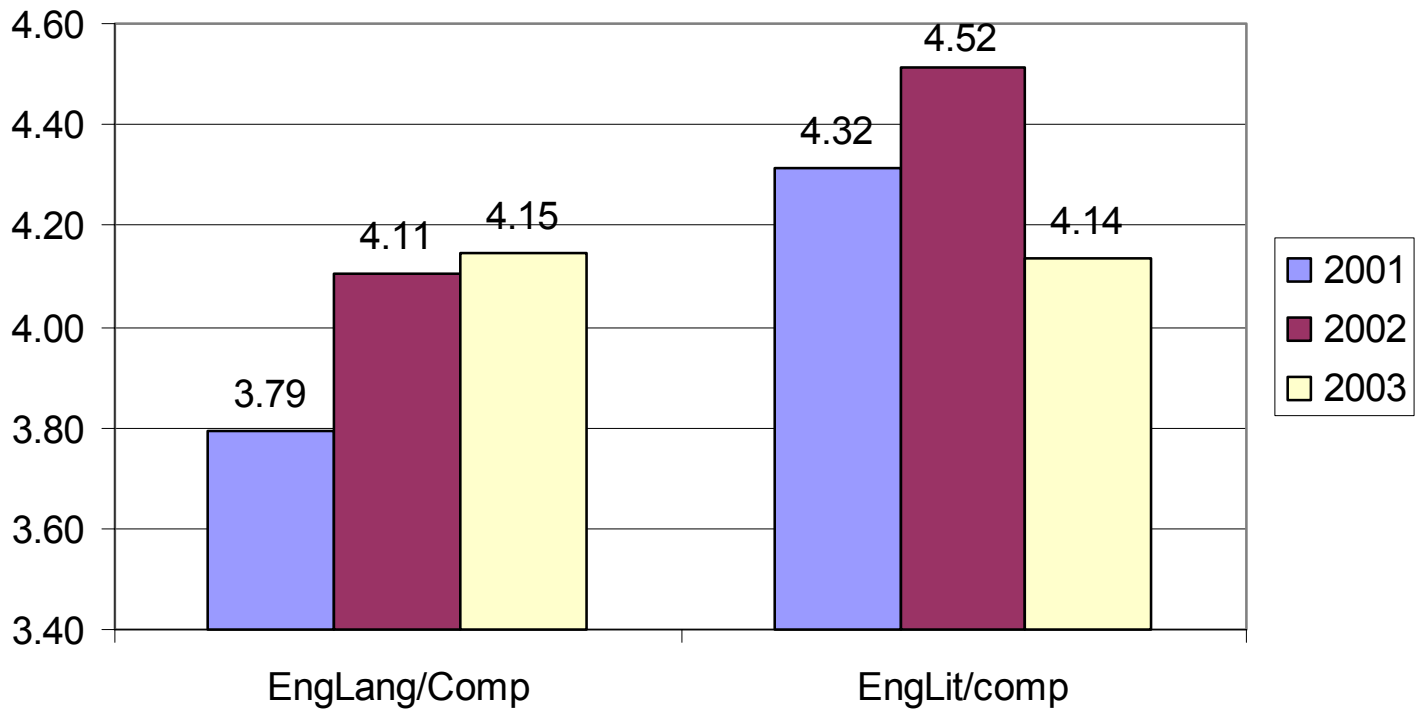


Advanced Placement Tests - 2003

- 519 tests were administered in 24 subjects
- 90% of the scores reported were a 3 or higher
- High correlation between grade in class and score on test (except world languages)

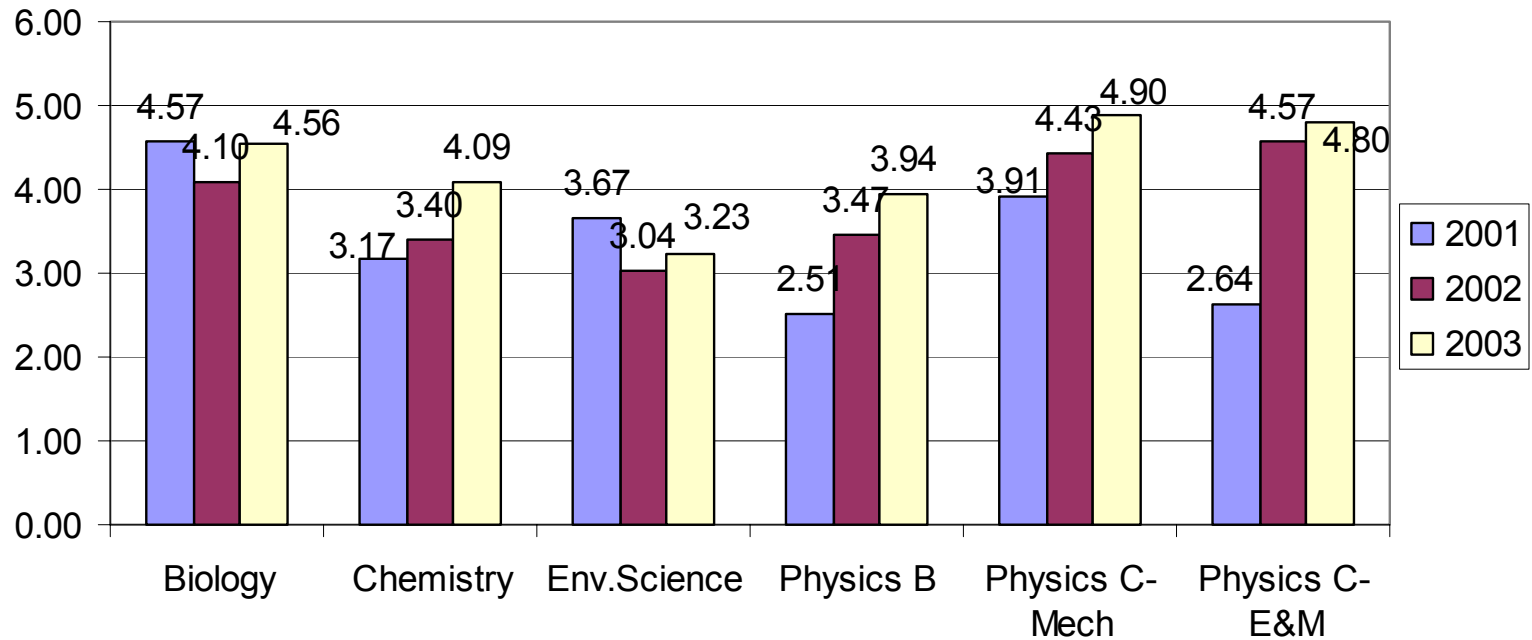

Average AP Scores for Language Arts Tests



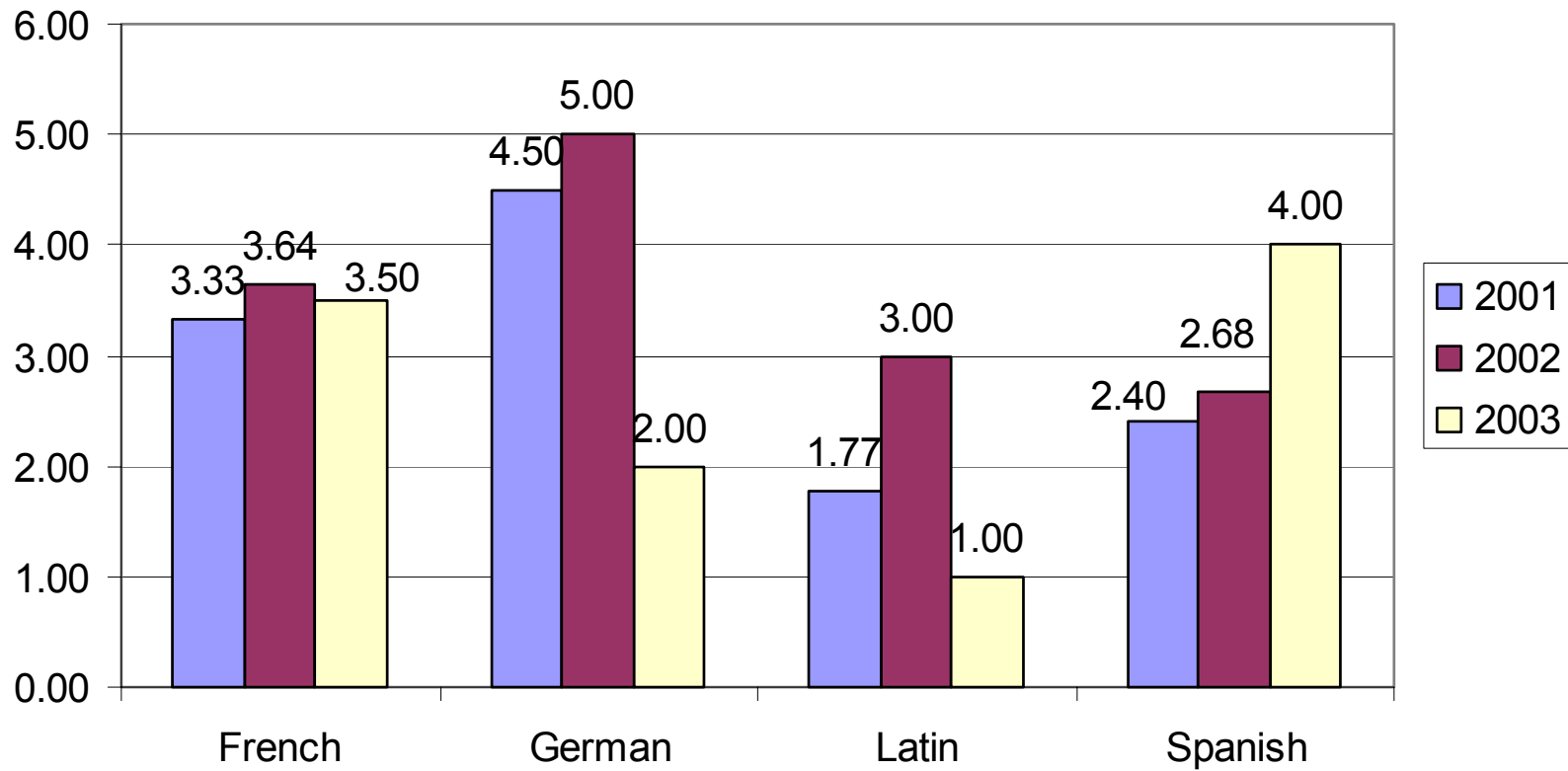

Average AP Score for Science Tests



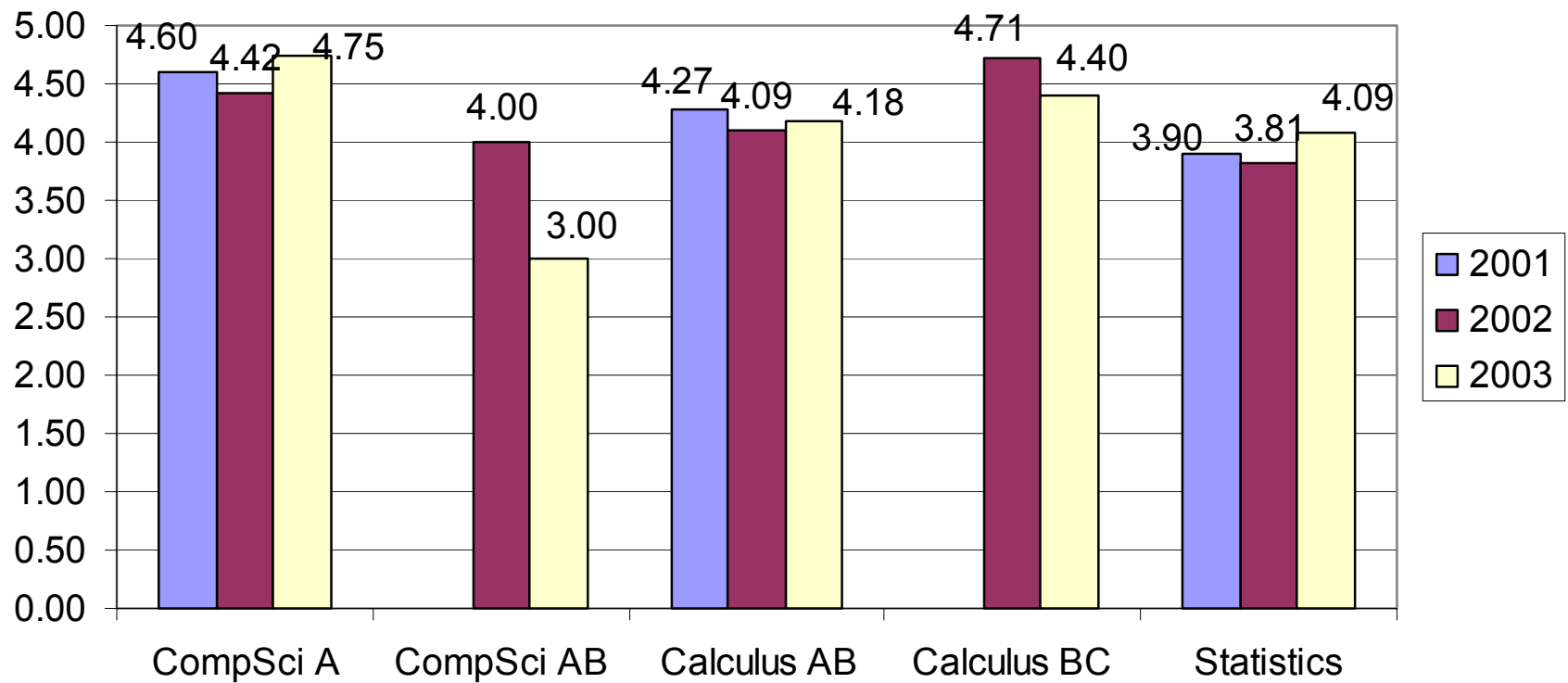
World Languages
