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Dear Parent or Guardian,

As students prepare for the SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) we are pleased to be able to offer an online SAT preparation program at no charge to any Ridge High School student. This program is developed by the College Board, the company who designs the exam, and allows students to prepare for the SAT at their own pace. Since the program is available to any 10th or 11th grade Ridge High School student, preparation for the exam can begin at any point in the year. In addition, the program is available online and allows access from any computer.

The website will contain the following resources:

- 18 interactive lessons that cover the new SAT math, critical reading and writing sections with quizzes after each section
- 6 practice tests with 1200+ questions from past SAT exams
- Personalized instant student feedback with auto essay scoring
- Answer explanations

The auto essay scoring system is a process by which student's essays are scored by a computer. This system uses artificial intelligence to emulate the process used by human scorers. Because of this feature, students will receive instant feedback on as many essays as they choose to complete. Please use the enclosed activation code to access the website and create your personalized account.

Any 10th or 11th grade student may obtain their individual access code from Judy Pavlik in Mr. Thompson's office beginning on January 12th. These codes will allow students to create individual accounts with no expiration date. In June, 9th grade students will be also able to obtain access codes from the same location.
