- using exercise equipment in the school's weight room
- playing pool/air hockey/ping pong
- painting or sculpting
- jewelry making
- bowling
- running or walking around the track
- roller skating/roller blading

Additional ideas or suggestions are always welcomed!!!

Some examples: A varsity wrestler who wants to teach wrestling, a musician who wants to teach my students to sing songs... This is an excellent opportunity for students to earn community service hours while having fun. Volunteers can come by themselves or with their friends.
